## GHURA to Host Town Hall Meetings for Public Input on CDBG-DR Action Plan

**Sinajana, Guam** (March 5, 2025) – The Guam Housing and Urban Renewal Authority (GHURA) invites the community to participate in town hall meetings to provide input on the use of \$500.8 million in Community Development Block Grant – Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds for long-term recovery following Typhoon Mawar in 2023.

As the designated grant administrator, GHURA is responsible for developing an Action Plan to ensure these funds address unmet needs in housing, infrastructure and public facilities, economic revitalization, and mitigation in disaster-impacted areas. This grant opportunity is only in the beginning stages, community feedback is essential in shaping funding priorities that reflect the needs of Guam's residents.

To engage the public and learn about this grant, GHURA will host town hall meetings in key locations across the island, including a virtual session, on the following dates:
